The foundation further seeks to empower and build self-reliant, confident and powerful women for the future through holding fellowships, camps, hands-on project trainings, charity donations of basic home needs including clothes, food, water, sanitary towels, home basic necessities, counseling, legal advice and protection, all in order to empower the girl child economically, psychologically, socially, financially and in many more ways.

We at **SHE HARBOUR FOUNDATION**, we strive hard each day to work in order to solve the biggest problems faced by girls, women and children across Uganda. The girl child struggles a lot with poverty, abuse, property loss, teenage pregnancies early marriages, and rape among others. Most children are not going to school, they face child labour and abuse, early marriages, poverty and for the girl child, education is not a priority in the African societies especially in the rural areas of Uganda.

Throughout history, women have been underprivileged and are always the minority group. This is due to the patriarchal society that girls are raised in, which encourages and brings up the male child as the superior of the girl child thereby making the girl child inferior in most things. This has lowered the self-esteem of so many girls in that so many cannot speak up on any issue for fear of the fact that girls are not supposed to have a say on any issue in society. Most societies have subjected the girl child to submissiveness to the male figure and this has led to so many rights violation of the girl child and miserable living standards. Our mission looks at making the society an equal livable place. We want to give confidence to girls, women and create a better society where both gender can co-exist equally in all aspects of life.

In Uganda, various girls miss school due to menstrual periods issues. Since they lack sanitary towels, some use soil, cow dung, leaves as sanitary towels. Therefore we look

This is all to empower women economically through giving them opportunities to start-up businesses and fight poverty and being self-reliant financially.
